## The “Josephine Frisbie Scholarship” — Scholarship Form —

The Frisbie-Frisbee Family Association of America has created the “Josephine Frisbie Scholarship” for members, their children and grandchildren. Josephine Frisbie, born in Red Cloud, Nebraska in 1906, was an English teacher in the Omaha School District, and nationally known as an educator. She generously bequeathed funds to be used towards a FFFAA scholarship program.

One scholarship for \$1000 will be awarded.

**Scholarship requirements:**

- Applicants must have been admitted to an undergraduate college, community college or technical school with the intention of receiving a degree from their chosen program.
- Grade Point Average of 3.0 or higher
- A list of High School extracurricular activities, public service activities and any awards
- 4 letters of recommendation from current teacher, counselor or non-relative
- Must be an Association member or a direct descendant (child, grandchild) of an Association member in good standing
- Copy of Letter of Acceptance from accredited college or trade school
- An essay no longer than 750 words to include:
  - An introductory paragraph
  - A paragraph related to a Frisbie–Frisbee ancestor that inspires you or whom you would like to emulate.
  - The main body of the essay should speak to how your educational goals will help advance your community directly and society as a whole.
- Application and required materials due February 15, 2017
